

ARTICLE 15

LEGAL STATUS PROVISIONS

SECTION 15.01 SEVERABILITY

- A. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the section or provision so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.
- B. Should any court of competent jurisdiction declare the application of any provision of this Ordinance to any lot, structure, or use to be unconstitutional or invalid, such declaration shall not affect the application of said provision to any other lot, structure, or use not specifically included in said judgment.

SECTION 15.02 REPEAL OF EXISTING ZONING ORDINANCE

The existing zoning ordinance of Superior Charter Township, being Ordinance No. 53, effective date of April 24, 1978, as amended, is hereby repealed. The adoption of this Ordinance, however, shall not affect or prevent any pending or future prosecution of, or action to abate, any existing violation of Ordinance No. 53, as amended, if the use, so in violation, is in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 15.03 EFFECTIVE DATE

Public hearings having been held, this Ordinance shall become effective on August 21, 1997, pursuant to provisions of Section 11, of Act 184 of the Public Acts of 1943, as amended.

Adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Charter Township of Superior, Washtenaw County, Michigan, at first reading on July 7, 1997 and at second and final reading on August 4, 1997 and amended on June 3, 2002, October 21, 2002, November 18, 2002 and December 2, 2002.
